II. New Business

- Approval of Resolution: Signatory Authority for EMPG Grant Programs – This annual Resolution will allow the Town to apply for these grants and gives Craig Baldwin the signatory authority for them. B. Jessurun moved to approve Resolution as presented. D. Smith seconded. All in favor.
- 2. Revision of STEAP Signatory Resolution/Date Clarification This Resolution gives C. Baldwin signatory authority for the Design & Construct EOC STEAP Grant. Eastern Conservation District MOU** This MOU has been presented by the Eastern Connecticut Conservation District with regard to US EPA Clean Water Act grant to supplement cost of septic systems replacements.
