NECOG also let the Town know that the Agricultural Viability Grant that they applied for the site had not been accepted by the state. However, NECOG may have the ability to fund a feasibility grant through other means. The following motion was made by J. Folsom and seconded by Joe Stoddard- "The Town of Pomfret requests that NECOG consider funding a feasibility study for small scale agricultural processing and distribution in

the Town of Pomfret." The motion carried by a 5-0 vote. N. Gardner will

inform the Board of Selectmen of the motion.

3) Pomfret Business Visitations- a visit to Loos & Co. is in the process of being

scheduled.

4) Build Out- N. Gardner attended a meeting at NECOG with State Officials

that looks at new tools for the Plan of Conservation and Development.

New Business:

1) CERC (Connecticut Economic Research Council) Review of Pomfret- N.

Gardner passed out the current CERC profile of the Town of Pomfret and reported on discussions that he had with staff at CERC. He also presented

a survey template that CERC would like the town to update. N. Gardner will work on the survey for the September meeting.
