**WHAT TO RECYCLE:**

Paperboard Boxes	Opened Mail
Paper Egg Cartons	Metal Jar Lids
Steel Bottle Caps	#1-7 Plastic Containers (rinsed)
Paperback Books	File Folders & Phone Books
White & Color Office Paper	Balled Aluminum Foil (rinsed)
Aluminum Foil	Glass Containers (rinsed)
Empty Aerosol Cans	Magazines, Brochures, Catalogs
Newspapers & Inserts	Cardboard
Aluminum Cans (rinsed)	Paper Milk/Juice Cartons (rinsed)

**WHAT NOT TO RECYCLE:**

Plastic Bags (trash & grocery); Non-Bottle Plastics (garden hose, zip lock bags, bubble wrap, clear plastic wrap, potato chip bags, single cheese wrappers, styrofoam, coolers, straws, plastic silverware); Wax Paper; Cereal Box Bags; Soiled Paper (used napkins); Pet Food Bags; Dryer Sheets; Shredded Paper; Windowpane, Plate & Windshield Glass; Ceramics; Candle Glass
