 Deborah Simpson, 64 Hampton Road – NOV issued 1/26/15 for work in a regulated area. J. Folsom asked Jamie if the Simpsons were putting in a septic system. Jamie said they installed the system but didn't do the remediation that has to be done. Letter was sent to the applicant on 9/18/18 as a reminder by Jamie. No response from application. Clerk sent a 2nd notice to applicant via CRR on 1/7/19. Response was received from application and work will be finished this year (5/1/19).
