- **I. OPEN REGULAR MEETING**: John Folsom opened the meeting at 7:00 pm.

V. PENDING APPLICATIONS:

- A. Deborah & Paul Simpson, 64 Hampton Road, septic system repair and landscaping (NOV for work in a regulated area without proper approvals). J. Folsom stepped down as Chair for this item and D. St. Martin stepped in as Chair. D. St. Martin read letter from Staff regarding the application. J&D Engineering is awaiting NDDH to do work. The status has not changed and the application is open.
