Help for Seniors as a Safe Affordable Housing Option

Bringing Home Providers and Home Seekers safely together

Home Providers who have space to spare in their homes are offering a private bedroom, shared use of the common areas of the house and a chance to live in a home rather than an apartment in exchange for a modest household contribution, well below current apartment prices. In exchange for services such as yard work, light house-keeping, errands or other jobs, a Home Provider may desire little to no household contribution. The most important aspect of Project Home Share is companionship and security for both the Home Provider and the Home Seeker.

Home Providers interested in more information about sharing their homes should call to arrange an interview to determine their needs and interests. This program is available to the fifty-six town service area of Senior Resources. One person in each home share arrangement must be age 60 or over; however, younger people are encouraged to inquire. We serve people regardless of race, color, religion, gender, sexual orientation, age, disability, place of birth, or national origin.
