



**POMFRET RECREATION SKATING
JAHN ICE RINK
RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. No children under 16 allowed to stay and skate without an adult with him/her to supervise.
2. **Guests will not be permitted to skate**, only paid season pass people are allowed on the ice. **You cannot substitute a guest for a member of your family.** If you purchased a “Single” (not family) season pass, only the person that the pass is written to can skate.
3. Food and drinks are prohibited while on the ice.
4. No video cameras or other electronic devices that could shatter on the ice if you fall down.
5. Smoking is prohibited in the building, including the locker rooms and on the ice.
6. Rough housing, hockey playing and/or hockey equipment, wrestling, tag, racing, crack-the-whip, etc. are prohibited. You cannot carry or “back pack” your children or anyone else on the ice.
Please Supervise Your Children.
7. No one is to go on the ice without skates.
8. No chairs or learn to skate devices allowed on the ice (unless approved by the Constable or a recreation commission member)
9. Pets are **not** allowed in the building.
10. Horn or whistle signals:
 - A) Leave the ice immediately when two long blasts are sounded.
 - B) Stay off the ice until two short blasts are sounded.
11. Do not go on the ice during the resurfacing operation.
12. For their own safety, spectators must stay behind the protective screening.
13. Do not enter the Players Boxes at any time.
14. You are skating at your own risk but, injuries should be reported to the person in charge of the group on the ice.
15. **Recreation skaters must wear winter hats at all times.** Pomfret School may cancel the membership of any skater on the ice without a hat! (**Baseball caps or headbands are not winter hats**)
It is recommended that children wear bicycle helmets for extra protection.
16. Pomfret School or the Recreation Dept./commission are not responsible for lost, damaged or missing articles. All skaters/spectators must act responsibly on the ice/rink area; disruptive behavior may result in dismissal from the program without reimbursement.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: A rink supervisor or Town Constable will be on duty and checking everyone upon entrance for their tags **and hats**.

NO HATS, NO TAGS, NO ADMISSION TO THE ICE, NO EXCEPTIONS!

If we are experiencing poor weather, listen to WINY 1350 AM for cancellation of skating

All families are asked to participate in supervising behavior of skaters both on the ice and off. Thank You.
