**The Pomfret Food Pantry** located in the basement of the Pomfret Senior Center at 207 Mashamoquet Road is open on Mondays from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. and on Tuesdays from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Residents coming in for the first time should bring proof of residency (such as an electric or phone bill with your name and address on it) and proper identification.

The Pantry is always looking for donations of the following items:

- Meats (canned)
- Fish (canned)
- Cereal
- Juice
- Beans (canned)
- Peanut Butter

We are not allowed to distribute homemade items such as canned jellies or preserves.
