- Bingo, Setback and Wii for your playing enjoyment and competitive spirit

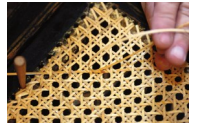

Wednesdays, Mar 7th, 14th, 21st, 28th– 9:00-10:00– Chair Yoga with Maryanne

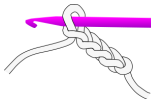

The caning courses have proven to be a great success at the center with participants learning the art of adding rattan cane and rattan peel to antique chairs to add to their historic beauty.
