Public Act No. 14-24 AN ACT CONCERNING BAZAARS AND RAFFLES will take effective on October 1, 2014. This revised law has a direct effect on the permitting process for Bazaars and Raffles.

The following procedural changes for Bazaar and Raffle applications will be implemented on October 1, 2014:

- Initial application intake will be DCP
- Applications should not be accepted at the municipal office
- DCP will collect their portion of the fee and qualify the Bazaar/Raffle
- DCP approved permit will be mailed to the municipality with the name and date of birth of each Designated Active Member for your approval
- DCP will notify the applicant that the permit is to be picked up at the municipality (enough time will be provided for your approval process)
- Municipality will collect their portion of the fee (fee to be collected will be listed on the permit) and issue the permit to the applicant
- Municipality will no longer have to sign Verified Statements (statements will be made available to you for inspection upon request to DCP)
