Our ultimate goal is to collect drop-offs and hold in a dry, protected building so the Swap Spot becomes the first place to look for something before heading to the store. Unfortunately, we currently have no storage and only two days in April, July, and October. So, for the foreseeable future:

- come early
- drop off and/or look for something you could use
- and remember, everything is free!
