

The Frog Rock Youth Basketball League is ready to start its 36th season!

As we had great league success with some exciting changes last season, we will keep the following formats for the 2018/19 season:

- 1. Division 1 (grades 3/4) will remain co-ed and recreational/developmental
- 2. Division 2 (grades 5/6) will consist of a boys-only house league and a girls-only Frog Rock team. The boys will compete against other Frog Rock teams and Woodstock recreation teams. The girls will compete against Putnam, Thompson, Woodstock, Killingly in a Sr. Girls Conference.
- 3. Division 3 (grades 7/8) will consist of a boys-only house league and a girls-only Frog Rock team. The boys will compete against other Frog Rock teams and Woodstock recreation teams. The girls will compete against Putnam, Thompson, Woodstock, Killingly in a regional WNBA conference.

Frog Rock Youth Basketball remains an instructional league where all the children in the towns of Eastford and Pomfret grades 3-8 are invited to play. Registration via this form is cash or a check payable to Frog Rock Youth Basketball. This year's registration fee is \$65.00 for the first child, and a \$110.00 maximum per family. Scholarships are available for those who find the registration fee to be a burden. Please discuss with a commissioner during registration.

- Shooting jerseys with personalized player names on the back

All players make a team and to best facilitate team selection player evaluation and instructional development, mandatory division-level practices will take place per below:

Plan to arrive at the beginning of the time slot for your division so you can participate in the various developmental/instructional drills. Team selection will be made December 1 after evaluations at which time players will be called by coaches for their team practices December 8, 15, and 22 2018. Games will begin Saturday January 5, 2019 and be held each ensuing Saturday morning through early-March. Game schedules will be distributed in late December/early January by your team coach. All games and practices are on Saturday mornings in the Eastford for division 1, PCS and Woodstock Middle for division 2 boys, Rectory School gym for division 3 boys and Rectory School gym for division 2,3 girls teams in addition to games in Killingly, Putnam, Thompson and Woodstock. Uniforms provided for return at end of season.
