

Pomfret Bulky Waste Tire Policy

Pomfret's provision of Bulky Waste Events are to provide town residents with a disposal option for those items not addressed through traditional subscription curbside MSW (Municipal Solid Waste) and Recycling Services. Included among the items accepted are scrap tires. To ensure that Pomfret is providing a fair and reasonable outlet for residentially sourced scrap tires, the town adopts the following tire acceptance policy:

For the Bulky Waste events, held three (3) times per year, only residential car and small truck tires are accepted, limited to four (4) tires per household or vehicle per event. Tires sizes greater than 19.5" will be accepted on a case by case basis. Decisions on acceptance will be made by the Town of Pomfret and its representatives on the days of the Bulky Waste event. Households with tires larger than 19.5", or quantities greater than 4 must contact the Selectmen's Office at Town Hall in advance regarding disposal options.

Pomfret's Bulky Waste events are not for the disposal of materials from commercial entities. Asking residential taxpayers to pay for the disposal of business tires and other materials is unfair. Thank you in advance for your cooperation and understanding.
