- 2. You must provide written & signed (by the program supervisor) records that will verify that you have performed community service (volunteer-not paid) to the town of Pomfret in some capacity i.e., The Recreation Department, any of the little league or soccer programs, girl scouts, boy scouts, senior citizen's, etc.
- 3. You must answer this year's essay question in writing to the best of your ability. (500 words or less)
