

**TOWN OF POMFRET
BOARD OF SELECTMEN MINUTES
MONDAY, OCTOBER 5, 2015 AT 6:30 PM
POMFRET COMMUNITY/SENIOR CENTER**

In Attendance: First Selectman Maureen Nicholson, Selectmen Barry Jessurun, Peter Mann. Also present: Terry Quinn with Tyler Technologies and approximately 14 citizens and interested parties.

I. Presentation-Tyler Technologies/Web Based Hosting for UCOA – M.

Nicholson introduced Terry Quinn who provided a presentation regarding web-hosted software. Included some discussion of the company background, capabilities of Infinite Visions software, cloud/internet access and hosting and the security layers provided. There followed some discussion and questions regarding intrusion protection, monitoring, access to personal info, liabilities, and the time-frame to be up and running once the switch from current programs begin. The presentation concluded at 7:25 with no further questions.
